




Materials (through FY 2024)

- 3,051,805 kilograms of liquid CO2
 - There's about 2.2 grams of CO2 in a can of Coke
- 2,616,580 gallons of liquid propane gas
 - A typical gas grill might last 18-20 hrs on a 4.6gal tank
- 9,375,278 kWh of electricity
 - The average US home uses 10,500 kWh/year
- 76 LP line valves replaced
 - That's about once every 43 days
- 78 induction fans replaced
 - The process takes about half an hour (if you're good)
- 576 MAU filters replaced
 - Filters are good for 3 years but require annual washing
- More than 800 hours spent on snow removal

Comments, Lessons, and Acknowledgements

- Don't tighten anything until you can tighten everything.
- When you're plowing snow, bring both trucks.
